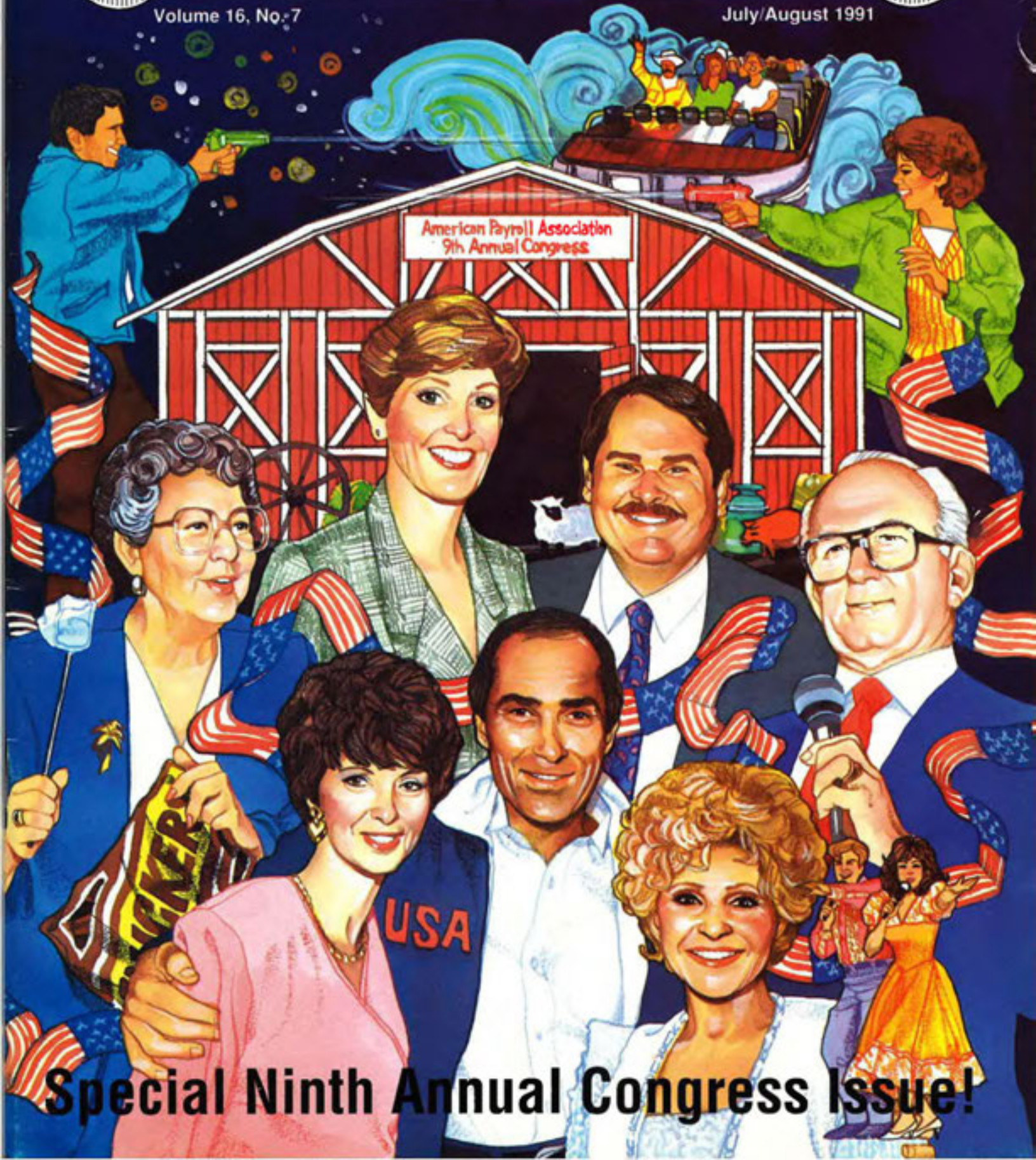

# 1991 Payroll Man of the Year

Jim Medlock happily approaches the stage to accept the Payroll Man of the Year Award.



**J**ames J. Medlock, CPP, Project Accountant for the Denver Water Department, was presented the 1991 Payroll Man of the Year Award during Friday's luncheon at the Congress.

Jim Medlock has spent thirteen and a half years in payroll as a payroll consultant, payroll supervisor, and the payroll accountant at the Denver Water Department. In addition to payroll, he has supervised accounts payable and accounts receivable.

As Project Manager Jim is responsible for the acquisition and implementation of an integrated financial software package. He has participated in the development, implementation, maintenance, and operation of computerized accounts payable, timekeeping, payroll, personnel, and billing systems. In addition, Jim was a team member of the Department's Information Strategy Plan and a team member of a project which analyzed the material acquisition and accounting functions at the Denver Water Department with the goal of acquiring new computer systems.

Jim earned his B.S. in Accounting from Oklahoma State University in 1974 and his M.S. in Accounting from Oklahoma State University in 1975.

He has been a member of the American Payroll Association since 1984, and his involvement with the APA has been extensive. He is President of the Denver Chapter, is Chair of the American Payroll Association's Certification Board, is a Contributing Writer to *Payroll Exchange*, and serves on the Hotline Referral Program. He is a member of the Government Affairs Task Force and participated in the first tax forms review meetings with the IRS. He has also served on the CPP Cut Score Panel, and was a Symposium and Congress speaker.
